To: Parents and Guardians

Re: Military Recruiter's Request for Student Information

The district periodically receives requests for personally identifiable information from military recruiters. There have been occasions where parents did not wish their child's information to be shared. It is the District's practice to honor those requests.

This practice is consistent with Ohio's Law on the confidentiality of student information.
R.C. §3319.321 (B)(2)(b) provides the following:

The names and address of students in grades ten through twelve shall be released to a recruiting officer for any branch of the United States armed forces who requests such information, except that such data shall not be released if the student or student's parent, guardian or custodian submits to the board a written request not to release such data.

As a result, the District cannot provide the names, addresses or phone number of secondary students to military recruiters if the student or his/her parent have instructed the District to withhold such information from the recruiters.
