Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to announce that the State ACT test without writing will be given to all juniors at Finneytown High School on Tuesday, February 20, 2019. Students need to arrive to school by 8:00 AM where they will be checked in and directed to their testing location. The test will take approximately 4-5 hours and students will be dismissed to go home at the end of the exam. They will have the option to pick up a packed lunch from the cafeteria.

The ACT test is one of two national college entrance exams. It is accepted and valued by all universities and colleges in the United States. The ACT is based on what students learn in high school and provides personalized information about their strengths for education and career planning. In addition, the state of Ohio has legislation requiring all juniors to take a college entrance exam.

In preparation for test day please bring:

- A photo ID
- Sharpened #2 wooden pencils, good erasers
- Calculator

Please be aware that this is a FREE official ACT test that can be used for college applications. When completing their demographic information at school, they will be given the option to send these scores, free of charge, to 4 colleges. Please talk to your student about where they would like to send their test scores. If they do not choose colleges during registration it will cost \$12.00 per college to send these ACT scores.

The other national college entrance exam is the SAT. We do not offer the SAT at Finneytown High School, however, students are encouraged to take both the SAT & ACT at least twice before the fall of their senior year. Students can register for the ACT national tests at www.act.org and the SAT national tests at www.collegeboard.org. There is a fee associated with the national testing dates.
