

Dear High School Parent/Guardian:

The Ohio Department of Education requires all districts to assess student learning each year in the spring. For students enrolled in Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, American History, American Government, English I, and English II, they will take an [end of course exam](#) to earn points towards graduation requirements. For each of the seven end-of-course state tests, a student earns one to five graduation points. Students have the potential to earn a total of 35 points. To meet this graduation pathway, a student must earn a minimum number of 18 points from the seven tests.

The district leadership team developed the following testing calendar for the Secondary Campus. Your high school student will test on the days identified in the calendar for the courses for which they are currently enrolled. It is important for you to ensure your child comes to school on testing days well rested and ready to show what they know!
