Residency Requirements for Enrollment at Finneytown Local School District

What does residency mean?

Residency is defined as:

- Being physically present in a household for significant periods
- Location where important family activities take place each day including sleeping, eating, working, relaxing and playing
- Place where the parent receives mail or where the parent is registered to vote, if applicable

What is required for proof of residency to enroll at Finneytown Local Schools?

Proof of residency is required for any new student enrolling in Finneytown Schools and for students who change addresses. Residency is confirmed by providing an original, or copy, of one (1) item from the first two lists below, all items from the third list and all applicable items from the fourth list:

1. One of the following
 - a. Deed or mortgage
 - b. Property tax statement
 - c. Lease (signed by both parties including the landlord's contact information dated within the last 12 months)
2. One of the following
 - a. Gas statement dated within the last 30 days
 - b. Electric statement dated within the last 30 days
 - c. Water statement dated within the last 30 days
 - d. Cable/Internet statement dated within the last 30 days
3. All of the following
 - a. Photo ID of the parent/legal guardian
 - b. Birth certificate
 - c. Immunization record
 - d. Current report card or transcript
4. All of the following that are applicable
 - a. Court order(s) allocating parents' rights and responsibilities or other documents describing custody or guardianship, if applicable
 - b. Copy of the IEP/ETR including signature page, if applicable
 - c. Copy of the 504 Plan, if applicable
 - d. Copy of the Gifted Education Plan, if applicable

Note that your student will not be enrolled until ALL of the above documents and forms are received and verified.
